The New Mexico Military Institute Summer Math Program is designed for high school Cadet-Candidates who complete and pass all admission requirements except the math admission exam. This program helps Cadet-Candidates develop necessary skills for success at NMMI; in fact, a recent Valedictorian attended the NMMI Summer Program.

Cadet-Candidates will live and study on the picturesque NMMI campus under the constant supervision of senior cadets, faculty, and staff. The academic facilities of the library, classrooms, computer labs and language lab are available, in addition to daily coaching from NMMI math professors.

OBJECTIVE:

The New Mexico Military Institute Summer Math Program mission is to successfully prepare Cadet-Candidates for the rigors of cadet life via:

- Early acclimation to New Mexico Military Institute's Academic Standards
- Early assimilation into the New Mexico Military Institute Corps of Cadets
- Early achievement of New Mexico Military Institute Corps of Cadet Physical Fitness Standards

APPLICATION PROCESS:

If the NMMI Office of Admissions recommends or requires the NMMI Summer Math Program, please promptly apply by submitting the attached application form. Once accepted, a confirmation letter and program details will be sent electronically.

Total Program Cost is \$3,250.00 USD. A non-refundable \$300.00 deposit is due after program acceptance and will be applied toward program fees. Deposit must be received by April 30, 2016 to reserve accommodations.

The \$2,950.00 balance is due upon arrival. A limited number of New Mexico Resident Grants are available to reduce New Mexico residents' program fees. Please apply by checking the applicable box on the application form.



Note: Despite the rigor of New Mexico Military Institute's Summer Math Program, attendance does not guarantee admission to New Mexico Military Institute. Official admissions notification for Fall 2016 will be communicated by the Office of Admissions on or shortly after July 29th - the last Friday of the Summer Program.

PROGRAM FORMAT:

The 2016 Summer Program begins 8:00 AM Wednesday, July 6th with an Opening Ceremony. Parents are encouraged to stay through lunch this day; however, candidates have placement testing at 1:00 PM. The summer culminates in a Completion Ceremony Wednesday morning, August 3rd - followed by NMMI Matriculation August 4th.
