

## Dow Hall

### AGE

- Dow Hall was originally constructed between 1956 & 1957

### SIZE

- Dow Hall is just over 22,000 s.f. in size on 2 levels.

### PURPOSE

- Dow Hall is an academic facility serving as the Military Sciences building and provides the academic curriculum for the Senior Reserve Officer Training Program.



### HISTORY

- Dow Hall originally constructed in 1957 has received several alterations during the past 50 years. In 1957-1964, the indoor firing range was altered, and in 1987 the facility received window and door replacements.
- The 2009 Dow Hall Renovation and Expansion Project brought Dow Hall up to compliance with all applicable codes (including building, electrical, fire, ADA, energy) and eliminated all known hazardous materials within the building.



### NAME

- Dow Hall was named in honor of Hiram M. Dow in 2005.
- Hiram M. Dow entered NMMI as a cadet in 1898 and graduated in 1905 as a First Lieutenant in "B" Company in the days when a Cadet Captain was the top. After his graduation from the institute, Mr. Dow attended Washington & Lee University where he graduated in 1908. He practiced law in Roswell for many years and served as a member of the NMMI Board of Regents from 1920 until 1930 and it's President from 1935 until 1951.
