

## Lusk Hall

### **AGE**

- Lusk hall was built in 1941

### **SIZE**

- Lusk Hall is approximately 31,000 S.F. in size on 3 levels.

### **PURPOSE**

- Houses the Superintendent, Dean, High School Principal, Academy Prep Program Staff, Chief of Staff, Regent office and conference room, Cashier and Business Offices, Human Relations, Purchasing, Registrar, Marketing, Legal, Admissions, and Financial Aid.

### **HISTORY**

- Constructed between 1938 & 1941 to house the NMMI Administrative offices and Horgan Library. The Horgan Library was moved in the 1980's when the Toles Learning Center was completed. Major updates have included the renovation of a partial HVAC (1980s), addition of an elevator and lift equipment, and re-roof.

### **NAME**

- Lusk Hall is named in honor of Colonel Ewing L. Lusk.
- Ewing L. Lusk, the “Colonel” – an outstanding educator of many talents. As engineer, teacher, high school principal, and ultimately Superintendent, he served NMMI from early 1911 until retirement in 1952.
