- chronic cardiac disease;
- severe symptomatic asthma;
- any severe neuromuscular or orthopedic disease or any other substantial physical limiting condition, which, in the opinion of the medical staff, would interfere with the cadet's performance and physical activity in accordance with New Mexico Military Institute's requirements.
- applicants with a medical or behavioral condition that could preclude their participation in required physical and academic programs will be reviewed by the Medical Review Board to determine their admission eligibility.

In addition to meeting reasonable standards of good health, applicants to the NMMI high school and junior college must demonstrate a pattern of good conduct, a willingness to accept responsibilities for their actions, and respect for others. Applicants must also meet academic, physical and English language competency standards as part of their admission, which may exclude students with specific disabilities. They must have exhibited the capacity to adjust to and work effectively in a closely supervised, highly disciplined and occasionally stressful environment, as well as the ability to live independently in a dormitory setting. **Initial Here:** _____
