ACADEMICS: The library will be for regular hours on Friday, October 30, 2020. Night study hall will resume on Sunday night, November 1, 2020. Math Lab will be open on Sunday evening, November 1, 2020. Science Labs will be open Tuesday and Thursday evening during Night Study Hall.

ATHLETICS: Beginning Monday, November 2, 2020, Coaches will resume responsibility for their team physical fitness. Corps PT will resume (weather dependent) on Monday, November 2, 2020. SROTC will be responsible for the ECP Cadets and Senior Chief Scott will supervise the PT for the Preps.

CORPS: Once you are cleared medically, you will be issued a GOLD colored wrist band. The GOLD band is a required uniform item and will be worn on your left or right wrist at all times until further notice. A GOLD band is required to enter buildings on post except for YOUR assigned room, adjacent sink room, and the infirmary.

Those of you who have quarantined on post will be issued a GOLD band this evening during SRC. This evening's SRC is required for all cadets on post. You are not to interact with any of the returning cadets while they are quarantined. Breaking quarantine is Endangering another Cadet (64/64) and will result in suspension.

Cadets that have quarantined off post will receive a GOLD band once cleared by the infirmary.

Again cadets without a GOLD band are strictly quarantined until cleared by the infirmary. While in quarantine you are restricted to your assigned room, the closest sink room, and the infirmary. You will be allowed to pick up meals delivered to sally port of your barracks. Breaking quarantine is Endangering another Cadet (64/64) and will result in suspension.

RETURNING CADETS:

1. Show time is 0830 to 1200, Friday, October 30th.
2. Cadets enter GAC NE door (just like matriculation), get tested, and exit through GAC NW door.
3. Go directly to their rooms or go to the Command Post to receive a room key. Bring four days of clothes/hygiene supplies (if making a temp move to different room will be notified by e-mail on Thursday)
4. Enter quarantine until test results are received. Meals will be delivered to the barracks starting with DRC on Friday.

CADETS MOVING TO DIFFERENT ROOMS:

1. Temporary move will begin Friday morning.
2. Bring PTs/ACUs
3. Up to four days of socks, t-shirts, underwear

4. Robe and shower shoes
5. Personal hygiene supplies
6. Mattress, linens/blanket
7. Books/laptop
8. Water container
9. Meals will be provided at Bates
10. Lock up personal items in wall/personal locker before leaving your room and bring your room key.
11. Male cadets in VMV will use the showers at the Athletic offices in the portables at Dow parking lot.
12. Female cadets in GAC will use the female locker room.

PLEASE NOTE THE 30 MINUTE TIME CHANGE TO 0830.

PARENTS AND RETURNING CADETS: Testing will take place in the Godfrey Athletic Center (GAC). Testing will take place between the hours of **0830** and 1200. Please line up on Kentucky and Achievement Avenues and wait in your vehicle. You will be called forward, screened, and then allowed to exit your vehicle to enter the GAC. If someone is bringing you to NMMI, you will pull up to the GAC, remove your personal belongings from the vehicle and enter the GAC from the NE door. The individual (s) bringing you will depart on Mustang Avenue and exit the Post on 19th Street; they will not be allowed to exit their vehicle or accompany you into the GAC.

If you drive yourself to NMMI – return your vehicle directly to the Cadet parking area. You will bring all of your personal belongings with you and report to the NE door of the GAC. You will enter the GAC and be tested.

2. They will need to Select Roswell as their testing site.

You will be tested at NMMI in the Godfrey Athletic Center. The NM Department of Health has asked that you pre-register for the test. The link is listed above. There is not an NMMI option on their website as a testing site. Select “Roswell” as the testing site.

RETURN TO POST PROTOCOLS FOR ISOLATION/QUARANTINE CADETS **PLEASE NOTE THE TIME CHANGE TO 0830**

All Cadets (see note for those Cadets that tested positive during the Corps wide testing) will be required to report to Post between 0830 and 1200 on Friday, October 30th, to be tested for COVID-19. We must have all tests completed and delivered to DOH by 1300 to be sent on a 1400 flight to their lab in Albuquerque. The tests will be administered by Department of Health personnel at no cost to the Cadets. There will not be a need for a second test.

All returning Cadets will be placed in quarantine pending the results of the tests.

Returning Cadets will be quarantined in their room and their roommate (if there is a roommate) will be moved during the quarantine period.

Rules during the quarantine period.

1. Cadets will be confined to their room or an assigned room.
2. Cadets will not be allowed to interface with other quarantined Cadets, or other members of the Corps.
3. Meals will be delivered to a common location in Saunders and Hagerman for pick up by the Cadet.
4. We are working with DOH to minimize the time in quarantine, the period may last as short as 24 hours or as long as four days.
5. Cadets will participate in class by remote instruction, while in quarantine, like you have been doing while off Post.
6. Any Cadet that tests positive will be moved to a dedicated isolation room. Cadets testing positive will be in isolation for 10 days.
7. As soon as all test results have been returned to NMMI, any Cadet testing positive will be moved into isolation and all other Cadets will be allowed to return to their assigned room.

CADETS THAT TESTED POSITIVE AND LEFT THE POST (THERE ARE 24 CADETS IN THIS CATEGORY) – YOU ARE TO RETURN ON SUNDAY, NOVEMBER 1ST, BETWEEN 0800 AND 1100. YOU WILL REPORT DIRECTLY TO THE INFIRMARY TO BE MEDICALLY SCREENED.

CADETS FAILING TO RETURN BY 1200 ON FRIDAY, OCTOBER 30:

If you miss the 1200 report time on Friday, **DO NOT REPORT LATER THAT DAY OR OVER THE WEEKEND.** We will not have the ability to test and we cannot allow you to return to Post and comingle with those who have been tested. You will be counted Absent Formation for Friday evening, all day Saturday and Sunday. You can report Monday, November 2nd from 0800 to 1200 to be tested. You will be required to pay for the private lab test of \$200 so that we can obtain the results quickly and integrate you back into the Corps. **Do not attempt to sneak back on to Post and return to your room or class. You will be stuck 64/64, a critical offense, Endangering Another Cadet.**
