**The Concept:** The Troops will participate in three events that will allow the RATs to demonstrate learned skills and acquired knowledge. Each event will be approximately 50 minutes in duration.

- **Knowledge Point.**
  - At this location, cadets will be challenged to demonstrate the skills learned and/or knowledge acquired during the initial RAT training phase.
- **Obstacle Course.**
  - At this location, cadets will be challenged to take part in the physical challenge of completing the obstacles within the course.
- **First Aid Round.**
  - At this location, the ROTC cadets will present First Aid instruction intended to further build the RATs skills as a cadet and citizen.
