Position: The Troop Leadership Advisor (TLA) is directly responsible for the safety, security, health and welfare, mentoring, counseling, discipline and accountability, and in-part, leader development of a troop of 60 - 90 cadets (with few exceptions) between 14 and 21 years of age.
