

ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
BETWEEN
NEW MEXICO MILITARY INSTITUTE,
ROSWELL, NEW MEXICO,
AND
CARSON NEWMAN UNIVERSITY, TENNESSEE

1. Purpose. This agreement New Mexico Military Institute (NMMI) and Carson Newman University establishes the relationship and responsibilities for the cooperative management and administration of the Military Junior College (MJC) 2+2 test Program. This program designates selected 4-year, 2+2 scholarship winners or Early Commissioning Program Lieutenants (ECP) to attend NMMI, an associate degree granting institution, for the first two years of the scholarship and then transfer to a baccalaureate degree granting institution, in this case, Carson Newman University.
2. Objective. This agreement provides a charter for NMMI to recruit 2 and 4-year scholarship recipients; provide the basic course of the Senior Reserve Officers' Training Corps and experience the leadership laboratory environment of the MJC; and transfer those desiring to attend Carson Newman, a baccalaureate degree granting institution; through three options (Appendix 1, 2, and 3), complete the Advanced Course and commissioning. The objective of this process is to validate that Military Junior Colleges can remain an integral factor in Army ROTC with the adoption of the MJC 2+2 Scholarship Program. Pursuant to this agreement, any credits earned toward the attainment of an Associate's Degree in Science at NMMI will transfer without prejudice for completion of the Senior Army ROTC Program and completion of a baccalaureate degree in nursing from Carson Newman University.
3. Program Responsibility. The decision authority for implementation, management and administrative procedures, as set out in this agreement, is vested jointly in the Commanding General, Cadet Command; the President/Superintendent, NMMI; and the President, Carson Newman University. This agreement will become effective when executed by the principals through their signatures on this document.
4. Period of Performance. This agreement sets out requirements for providing 4-year scholarship winners or ECP cadets to be enrolled at NMMI. This agreement will commence in school year 2015-16 and will continue until either party deems necessary to discontinue. This agreement allows for enrollment of freshmen 4-year scholarship winners from NMMI as transfer students to Carson-Newman University. This agreement is renewable each year without the execution of a new agreement unless either party deems necessary revisions.

5. Definition of Terms.

- a. Basic Course --Military Science Levels I and II.
- b. Advanced Course Military Science Levels III and IV.
- c. Early Commissioning Program (ECP) 2Lt-a cadet that completes the ECP program at NMMI and graduates and commissions into the USAR/ARNG at the end of their sophomore year.
- d. Eligible Recruiting Population --Names provided to NMMI to recruit applicants for attendance at NMMI and receipt of a 2 or 4-year Army ROTC scholarship.
- e. 4-Year Scholarship Offer --A legally binding offer to provide scholarship benefits for up to four years. Current scholarship benefits pay for tuition or room and board and mandatory fees. Additional benefits are: a book allowance of \$1,200 per year, a tiered subsistence allowance starting at \$250 per month, and a uniform commutation allowance while at school.
- f. Baccalaureate Degree Producing Program --A program of instruction that will allow an individual to receive a Baccalaureate Degree. Additionally, this program must be at a school where the Army ROTC Advanced Course is available.

6. Agreements and Understandings. The parties to this memorandum of agreement hereby agree to the following:

a. New Mexico Military Institute will:

- (1) Assist the Professor of Military Science (PMS) in recruiting high quality cadets to receive a scholarship offer.
- (2) Assist the PMS in tracking the graduates of the basic and/or advance courses.
- (3) Assist the cadets in being placed in a baccalaureate degree-producing program.
- (4) Assist the cadets in transferring to Carson Newman University or another baccalaureate degree producing institution upon completion of the ROTC basic course and attainment of an Associate degree.
- (5) Ensure all courses each 2+2 or ECP cadet enrolls in will be transferable to Carson Newman University (Appendix 1,2, and 3).

b. New Mexico Military Institute ROTC PMS will:

- (1) Receive a list of names and addresses from the national 4-year application list to be used in recruiting.
- (2) Provide the necessary administrative support for those cadets selected for participation in the MJC 2+2 Or ECP Scholarship Program.
- (3) Coordinate with the NMMI Admissions Department and HQ CC in making the scholarship offer. During the period of attendance at NMMI the enrolled scholarship cadet's tuition and fees will be paid at the same rate as the Dedicated Military Junior College Scholarship.

c. Carson Newman University will:

(1) Accept transfer students from NMMI without loss of credit toward any degree offered. This acceptance is based on academic grade point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale, an average GPA in Science of 2.5 minimum and a minimum grade of "C" in each course required for graduation (Appendix 1, 2, and 3).

(2) Set tuition rates for in-state and out-of-state 2+2 cadets, attending CN, equal to Carson Newman University tuition rates for 2+2 cadets attending CN, providing each 2+2 cadet *living on campus*, a CN grant to be applied to the charges for a double occupancy room and up to an unlimited meal plan after federal and state grants are applied.

(4) Apply university aid awarding policies equally to all ROTC cadets (for both continuing and new cadets.) Awarding policies are explained in the "University Reduction of Aid Policy" and "The ROTC Scholarship Program" in the Carson-Newman University Catalog.

7. Changes. Any party to this agreement desiring to change this agreement shall provide a draft copy of the proposed change to the other parties for review and approval. No change to this agreement will become effective unless mutually agreed to in writing by the undersigned parties.

8. Termination. Recognizing the interests of the Army, NMMI and Carson Newman University, each of the parties reserves the right to terminate this agreement as specified in this paragraph. Any Termination Notice must be in writing bearing the signature of the individual empowered by the respective party to terminate the agreement. Ninety (90) days' notice must be given before exercising the right to terminate. Should this agreement be terminated by the Army before the completion of the agreement's full term as specified herein, the Army shall have no obligation to contract new 4-year 2+2 scholarship cadets at Carson Newman College. The Army will continue to pay scholarship benefits for those cadets enrolled in the program. NMMI agrees that should it desire to terminate this agreement it will continue to provide academic credit for those cadets currently in the MJC 2+2 or ECP Scholarship Program. Carson Newman University will continue to provide academic credit for those cadets currently in the program and agrees to accept NMMI 2+2 cadets or ECP 2L's currently enrolled at NMMI. New cadets, either as new enrollments or replacement cadets, will not be entered into the MJC 2+2 Scholarship Program except by mutual agreement of the parties once intent to terminate the agreement has been conveyed to the appropriate parties.


9. Responsible Offices.


