Cadet Life-Coach

New Mexico Military Institute announces an opening for a Cadet Life-Coach. This appointment is a 10 month per year position. This position oversees and coordinates intervention programs and other actions that are categorized as “High Risk” behavior. This position requires the Life-Coach to be part of an Inter-Disciplinary Review Board; administer, assess and evaluate questionnaires, surveys and testing concerning research and life coaching services; to be familiar with local and state counseling and community support services; and maintain an International Coaching Federation (ICF) recognized Life-Coach Certification. This position requires excellent communications skills to including; report writing, proposal writing, record-keeping, and teaching occasional classes as required. Knowledge and experience in crisis intervention is a critical component of this position. A Bachelor of Arts (B.A.) or a Bachelor of Science (B.S.) degree in psychology, education, sociology, or social work from a regionally accredited institution is required. A Master’s Degree in psychology, education, sociology, or social work is preferred. Non-certified Life-Coaches will be required to complete Level I certification within 90 days of hire.
